Woodwind players: Do not forget to stock up on reeds for all your instruments! Check your cases for extra reeds (especially those of you that march a different instrument than concert season).

Low Reeds/Brass Players: If you are renting an instrument from the school, you will need to complete a rental form during Band Camp.

Concert Band

All instrumentalists should have their instruments for rehearsals.

If you own your instrument it is a good idea to have it cleaned over the summer. If you didn't take it in last summer it is a necessity that you do this summer. Think of it like this; you wouldn't wear the same swimsuit every day for 9 (or 18) months and never wash it...eww!!

Reed players need to supply their own reeds. Reeds can be easily purchased online through www.wbw.com or at one of our local music stores. Clarinet and Saxophone players should be playing on Vandoren reeds, minimum strength 2.5 (Concert Band). If you are in Jazz you should be playing on Vandoren Javas (Jazz Band).

Percussionists should also have a stick bag with the following for concert band:
