**Fundraising Report – Joan Nink / Jenny Dugan**

- Sale is in full swing, due Thursday and Joan will pick up order forms from Noah on Friday
- Once envelopes are sorted, fundraising totals per student will be given to Ms. Lato to apply to trip expenses
- Checks are handed over to East so hard to know when they will be deposited
- Erin will write check to East for money that is collected on Square
- Dianne may need to match up students with online sales as details might not be provided

**President's Report – Jill Sanfellippo**

- Mr. Hughes was able to contribute funding to travel expenses
  - We will cover up front and be reimbursed
  - Will connect again in May to discuss funding for next year's budget

**Vice President's Report – Jessica Fugere**

- No response from calls to Chipotle – Jessica will stop in soon to set up a date

**Treasurer's Report – Erin Margerie**

- Financials sent out to Board – BMO balance of \$72,423.50
- Income includes \$3,759 of spirit wear money – Erin will write a check to East
- New raffle license is on the way and should be available for November 5 event
- Expenses include our liability policy premium

**Corresponding Secretary's Report – Dianne Crowley**

- There were a few online transactions
- Social media posts have been getting good response – especially high viewing of Mr. Manke 'getting sturdy' on Tik Tok

**Special Projects Chairperson – Tom Hoffer**

- Last regular season game this Friday night – need more volunteers with forecast and likelihood of high Hot Chocolate sales; Tom will not be available as early that day
- One playoff game remaining
- Averaging \$3,000 / game with 54% margin and total sales of \$14-15,000
- Selling out of perishable items and will not restock as season comes to an end
- Tom brought items that will be needed for State lunch-making – ketchup, mustard, napkins, zip-loc bags, etc
  - Count of 73, but Tom will plan for 80 when purchasing other food items
  - Will buy other items Thursday and drop to Noah at 4:00 that afternoon

- Last year, kids that ordered vegan meals were given shredded lettuce on a roll – Jill will pick up extra veggies on Friday to provide more options
- Sara left great notes from last year so should go well assuming we will get more volunteers to pack lunches
- We will have plenty of cookies
- Tom will donate Bucks tickets for two nights – January 6 against the Hornets and Feb 4 against Heat – to the November 5 Silent Auction
- Tom has some financial items to hand over to Erin

#### **Brewer Coordinator – Lisa Hollander**

- Brewer season is over and successful fundraiser totaling around \$30,000 – with half of that going to us and half to Cross Country
  - Potential to split season commitment with Tosa West next year
  - Still waiting on cash tips
  - Bonus will be up to \$7,000
  - Will plan for a training night in January
- Leff's back room is booked for the November 5 Meet and Greet / Silent Auction
  - Information was included in latest Smores newsletter
  - Lisa has a donation request letter to use if anyone needs it
  - Would like to have 16-20 auction items – forward any items or ideas to Lisa
  - Jill will check with Nick regarding items he can donate
  - Jill can send email and will ask Dianne to create a Facebook event

#### **Volunteer Coordinator Report – Meg Fifarek**

- Will plan to put lunch-packing and cookie-making on master volunteer sign-up next year
- Looking at plan to make some uniforms larger by putting expandable panel in existing jackets
